The Role

An exciting opportunity to join the Arbor School as the Theatre and AV Technician is now available. The successful candidate will be responsible for ensuring the smooth operation and maintenance of audio-visual equipment and systems within the school. Your primary focus will be on supporting the faculty and students in their use of AV technology for instructional purposes, presentations, events, and other school-related activities. The Post-holder will be responsible for the smooth running of technical elements of events across the school site. Specifically, from a sound and video perspective but also the ability to assist in other areas of technical setup including staging builds, carpentry, working with lighting, and as stage manager.

This role will optimise the already impressive range of opportunities for students to enrich their learning at Arbor through the expressive arts. In its current form, Arbor utilises its own staff as well as third parties to provide a range of technical support, with a limited usage of the facilities outside of school hours. The aspiration of Arbor is to continue to develop the breadth and value of enrichments, and to enhance the quality of performances and events across the school.

We seek an individual who is enthusiastic and energetic, possessing the wide range of abilities to work effectively in a fast-paced and high-achieving environment. The successful individual will have the ability to link with Arbor School staff (including academic, operational and leadership), parents, students, and the wider community. When the facilities are being provided to external users, this individual may be responsible for managing the facility to ensure its integrity and safety, and therefore needs to be prepared to demonstrate some flexibility in their agreed working hours which may occasionally include weekends. The successful individual will optimise all resources - human, physical and digital - to make efficient usage of spaces and facilities at Arbor and will build systems and processes to ensure the ongoing success of the programme. The candidate should possess excellent communication skills to enable effective dialogue with colleagues, staff, visitors and where applicable, pupils; have the ability and confidence to work at height using a range of access equipment including ladders and lifts; be organised and self-motivated, with a proven record for meeting targets and deadlines; and be able to perform well and remain professional whilst under pressure.

To succeed in this role, you should have had previous experience in a similar role either within a school or similar technical position. The successful candidate will play a key role in fulfilling the school's vision. This is an exciting opportunity to join the team of an extraordinary ecological school in Dubai, based on the National Curriculum for England with a core philosophy centred upon ecoliteracy, sustainability and environmental justice. The school facilities are unique, and include six biodomes, learning gardens, maker spaces and extensive provision for both sports and the arts. We therefore invite applications from exceptionally hard working and motivated professionals, who are excited by the opportunity to take a significant role in shaping a truly outstanding and unique education. We seek an individual who is passionate and curious, who can form excellent relationships with colleagues, parents and students, and who values the wellbeing of their students above all else.
